NPS/LEYHILLS M&M IN-HAND WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P(UK) KESTON ROYAL OCCASION IN HAND

This Competition is open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books.

1. Small Breeds, Yearling 2 & 3 year old , Colt, Filly or Gelding.

Exhibits to be registered in the Part-Bred section of their Breed Society, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, any height, riders any age – Will be split into not exc 148cms and exc 148cms if entries warrant

This competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings 4, 5 or 6 year olds. Ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Stud Book, register or Appendix, international or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland stud books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB

. Ponies not to have qualified for RIHS or Horse of the Year Show, Ponies not to have been placed first in Any affiliated Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony class prior to the commencement of the current Winter Series (excluding Leading Rein or First Ridden). All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bit. Riders any age except stallions – see NPS rules

7. NPS/CHECKLEYBANK & P(UK) Colne M&M NOVICE LEADING REIN WINTER

CHAMPIONSHIP This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 122cms. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any Leading Rein class. To be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle, the leading rein must be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands.

Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 9th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

8.. NPS & P(UK) Waxwing M&M NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 128cms. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any First Ridden class. Ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 12th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

9. NPS / T.C. TACK & THINGS M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P(UK) Colne Leading Rein Championship

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 122cms. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 9th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year)

10. NPS/KBIS M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P(UK) Waxwing First Ridden Judge: Mrs V Hampton

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book.

Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 128cms.

Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 12th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year)

TINY TOTS CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd from classes 6 - 10 to compete

14. NPS/HIRSTMUND STUD M&M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – large breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden Mountain & Moorland Class prior to the commencement of the current Winter Series. All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bridle. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

15. NPS / FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P(UK) Confined Novice Ridden Championship– small breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class.. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

16. NPS / FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P(UK) Confined Novice Llanarth Ridden Championship – large breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class. . Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

NPS / SNUGGY HOODS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – small breeds & P(UK) Llanarth Ridden Championship This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

18. NPS / SNUGGY HOODS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – large breeds & P(UK) Llanarth Ridden Championship This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

These classes may be divided this class by height, according to the current Rule Book, unless entries warrant otherwise this will be run as a mixed height class with fenced adjusted for each section and *1st 2nd and 3rd to qualify*

RULES:

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become Adult Showing members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2012. The owner must be a full member of the NPS for the pony to enter the NPS/PRP Equestrian Rescue M & M WHP RIHS Championship

This show is a qualifier for the 2012 P(UK) Winter Championship Show The 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each qualifying class will qualify. Competitors in qualifying positions who are not current members of P(UK) are allowed 14 days in which to become members and register their ponies/horses in order for the qualification to remain valid

No qualification cards will be awarded in the ring

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply.

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify for NPS qualifiers. Winnings in the 2011/12 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2011 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions.

Riders of small breed stallions must be 11 years or over, riders of large breed stallions must be 14 years or over

The Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any Class with less than 3 entries or sub-divide any class.

Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the class being judged, accompanied by £20.00. Deposit returnable if the objection is upheld.

The Committee will not be responsible for any accident to animals, persons or property.

The decisions of the Judges and Committee are final.

It is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter their ponies in the correct class or classes.

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full fees.

No Ponies may be plaited in M & M Classes.

Correctly secured British Standard skull caps/riding hats BS 4472 or BS 6473 or PAS 015 or latest standard must be worn at all times when mounted.

All children 14 years and under must wear HARD HATS when showing in-hand.

No loose dogs allowed on the showground/arenas.

In all ridden classes the wearing of SPURS is forbidden.

Show canes/whips must not exceed 30".

Children must be three years old before competing in any ridden class.

All ponies entered in M & M classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books.

This also applies to horses/ponies entered as partbred M&M.

Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form and with entries on the day.
